

SELLING ALCOHOL TO MINORS

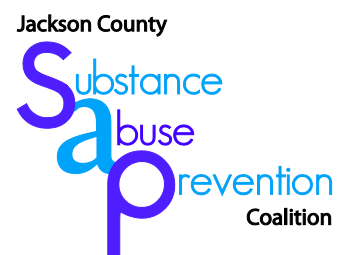
IS ILLEGAL

A retail licensee and/or a retail clerk/employee who sells or furnishes alcohol to a person under 21 years of age:

- Is guilty of a misdemeanor
- Can be fined up to \$100.00 for each offense

**VIOLATIONS CAN RESULT IN A
SUSPENDED OR REVOKED LICENSE.**

“Required signage about the penalties for selling to a minor must be posted in an obvious place in each room where alcohol is sold.” (see enclosed sign: LC-602, Rev. 01-09)
